Here are some important details you need to know and instructions you need to follow if you plan on attending any in-person Worship Service for the next little while:

1) We will have a capacity limit of 30 people. Unlike the summer and fall, where we had a higher capacity limit, this will be a hard, non flexible limit. Due to this, and the need to maintain records of who is attending should contact tracing be required, you must confirm your intent to attend Service by 7pm the day before (7pm Saturdays for Sunday Worship and 7pm Tuesdays for Wednesday Service). You must email or text me (jordanwall3@gmail.com or 204-898-4477) with the names of everyone planning to attend. You can RSVP on behalf of others you know who would like to attend (ie family members without email), we just need to know the full name of everyone attending.

I will confirm with you that we have room and you can attend. If you do not receive confirmation from me that you can attend, please do not attempt to. **Anyone attempting to attend who has not RSVP'd and received confirmation from me will NOT be allowed into the Church.** I thank you in advance for your help and understanding with this.

2) Many things will remain in place from the fall. Masks are mandatory within the Church. Hand sanitizer is provided and we encourage all to use it when entering and leaving the Church. Please maintain 6ft physical distance at all times, and do not congregate in areas that block safe traffic flow (ie the hallway leading to the parking lot door). We have maintained the extra disinfection cleaning service we added in July, which includes disinfection of things like countertops, bathrooms and door handles. At this time, for those who need one, we do have some masks available, but we encourage everyone to bring their own.

3) One change from the fall is on entering and leaving the building. As we do not have people attempting to enter and leave at the same time, and given the extra distance on potentially slippery sidewalks, everyone will enter and exit the building through the parking lot entrance (like most of us do in normal times). This will allow us to properly maintain who is attending. This door will be locked around 11:15am to ensure no one from the community is attempting to enter as we are not open to the public at this time with our 30 person limit.

4) Like we did in July, we will be having Communion every Sunday in February, then returning to our normal Communion schedule of the first and third Sundays of every month starting in March. So really we will be celebrating it for the next 4 consecutive Sundays, as well as Ash Wednesday.

5) For the time being, Sunday School and Bible Study will remain online only. If you have a child or grandchild not currently taking part in the online Sunday School, but would like to, please contact Karen Hill. Bible Studies are uploaded regularly to our YouTube page.

6) We will continue to provide the online services so you'll still get an email from me everyone Saturday, which will hopefully serve as a reminder to RSVP for Sunday and Wednesday Services.
